

Confirmation of Compliance with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste

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Spanabhebende Präzisionswerkzeuge GmbH - hereinafter referred to as SPPW - confirms that the packaging and packaging components for which it is responsible and which are identified as inspected and approved in the currently valid internal packaging register comply with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste applicable at the time they are placed on the market.

This confirmation applies to packaging and packaging components placed on the market from 12 August 2026 onward.

In particular, it is confirmed that the sum of the concentration levels of

- lead,
- cadmium,
- mercury, and
- hexavalent chromium

in the relevant packaging and packaging components does not exceed the limit of 100 mg/kg in accordance with Article 5(4) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.

This confirmation is based on the material and packaging specifications, supplier declarations, test reports and other technical evidence available to SPPW.

The packaging used by SPPW for cutting tools is not intended to come into contact with food. The specific PFAS limit values for food-contact packaging pursuant to Article 5(5) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 therefore do not apply to this packaging. This statement does not constitute a general confirmation that the packaging is PFAS-free.

Where SPPW is the manufacturer of the respective packaging within the meaning of Regulation (EU) 2025/40, the required technical documentation is prepared, the prescribed conformity assessment procedure is carried out and the EU Declaration of Conformity is issued in accordance with Articles 15, 38 and 39 and Annexes VII and VIII before the respective packaging is placed on the market. The documents are retained for the periods required by law.

The legally required documents will be made available to the competent authorities upon reasoned request. Customers will receive the information and evidence required to fulfil their own legal obligations insofar as SPPW is required to provide such information. Confidentiality requirements will be taken into account.

The internal packaging register is continuously updated and the respective versions are archived. Any changes relevant to conformity are assessed and documented before the packaging concerned is subsequently placed on the market.

This confirmation will be reviewed in the event of significant legal, technical or material-related changes and updated where necessary.

This confirmation provides summary information on compliance with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. It does not constitute an EU Declaration of Conformity pursuant to Article 39 and Annex VIII of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 and does not replace such a declaration.
